**Competition format, rules:**

All rounds of competition are organized according to UCI Regulations and Rules.  
Clip pedals are allowed only for riders 13 yrs and older.

The invitations will be published a minimum 3 weeks before the event on the event web page. They will also be sent by email to all federations and participating clubs.

**Age of riders:**

Race is open for all riders – with or without National BMX license. Riders who don't have license must show BMX race insurance prior registration.

According to UCI Regulations – riders' categories are determined by the age of those competing as defined by the difference between the year of the event and the year of birth of the rider. A rider must be at least 5 years of age to compete in a BMX event.

**Categories:**

**Challenge categories:**

Cruiser: CR13/29, CR30+;

Girls: G5/6, G7/8, G9/10, G11/12, G13/14, G15/16

Boys: B5/6, B7/8, B9/10, B11/ B12, B13/14, B15/16

If there will be less than 3 participants then they will be added to the next age group.

**Open categories (open for all participants age 13+):**

Women: Pro Open

Men: Pro Open

Open categories will use the pro section.

**Registration:**

Registrations by **Wednesday ( 15. 07. 2020)** before the race, payment possible by bank transfer to organizers bank account and in cash on place.

Late entries double fee.

**Awards in cup races:**

Organizer will provide trophies for top 3 riders in all categories and medals or product prizes for all finalists (places 4-8).

**For Open categories**, top 3 riders receive prize money. Prize money budgets are made from Open riders' registration fees, plus 200 EUR from organizer.

Breakdown of prize money is following:

Women (100 EUR from organizer): 1<sup>st</sup> place – 50%; 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 30%; 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 20%.

Men (100 EUR from organizer): 1<sup>st</sup> place – 50%; 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 30%; 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 20%.
